




Mapping disease convergence across Peru, 2014 to 2016 (manuscript in preparation)


Study Area: Piura, Peru




Sea surface temperature anomalies in Nov. 2023

Does the definition affect perception of risk and societal responses?





## **Big Picture (Policy Implications)**

- Training the future generation of inter- and multidisciplinary scholars and practitioners (cross-disciplinary, cross-cultural workforce)
- Multi-risk reduction strategies, Ecosyndemic geospatial surveillance and monitoring system, Web-based tools, StoryMaps
- Integration of regional definitions to enhance early warning/early actions for El Niño
